Re: COVID-19 Cluster situation at Moshier Jordan Residence Hall

Since August 31st, there have been 11 reported positive COVID-19 cases in Moshier Jordan. We are seeing the cases predominantly on the 5th floor and have determined that targeted testing on this floor is prudent at this time.

Residents of the 5th floor are required to get tested for COVID-19. Arrangements have been made for those individuals and they will be contacted separately.

All residents should monitor their health by completing the [ResponsiBLUE Symptom Tracker](#) daily. Continue to maintain 6 feet of social distancing at all times, wear face coverings and wash hands frequently. Residents on other floors are also encouraged to sign up for priority testing to be tested through the Community Sampling and Tracking program at this [link](#).

Anyone that has symptoms should contact UHS at 734-764-8320 to be assessed and moved for separation, if necessary.
