Re: Required COVID-19

As you have been previously notified, there have been two COVID-19 cases identified among residents of Munger. Because of the fact that the B.1.1.7 variant has been identified and that many in Munger do not fall into our mandatory weekly testing program requirement, we are **requiring ALL Munger residents** to get tested 2 times this week through the Community Sampling and Tracking program at this [link](#).

As always, we ask that our community do the following:

1. Continue to monitor your health daily by completing the [ResponsiBLUE Symptom Tracker](#). This is a requirement for all individuals on campus daily.
2. Limit social interactions.
3. Wear a mask when around anyone outside your immediate household.
4. Anyone that has symptoms or a high risk or known exposure, should contact [University Health Service](#) (UHS) at 734-764-8320 or [complete the online assessment](#) immediately.

We are asking that everyone share in the responsibility to complete their testing and take precautions. EHS will continue to monitor the case situation closely. We want to reassure everyone that we take your health and safety seriously.
